

Supplemental Funding Request for the Superior Court of Tehama

On January 20, 2016, the Superior Court of Tehama County submitted an application for supplemental funding for costs of \$498,000 due to extraordinary expenditures from malicious actions that occurred in July 2015 rendering the court's information technology infrastructure non-operational.



Review of Superior Court of Tehama County's Application

Percent Funding Request Review
Subcommittee met to review and consider
options for the Superior Court of Tehama
County's supplemental funding
application.



Superior Court of Tehama County

- Supplemental funding request of \$498,000 for projected 2015–2016 negative fund balance (General Fund) of \$237,000.
 - Court indicates negative fund balance caused by an estimated \$498,000 for the extraordinary expenditures that the court has had to incur after malicious actions rendered the court's case management system, telephones, exchange server, jury system, shared and individual drives, and website non-operational.



Superior Court of Tehama County

- 2 Percent Funding Request Review Subcommittee recommended option 2.
 - Option 1: \$0 Layoff staff and reduce counter and telephone hours.
- Option 2: \$272,000 to the Tehama County court for its 2015–2016 General Fund operational deficiency and for a fund balance amount equal to half of the court's contributed share to the 2 percent state-level reserve thereby approximating the maximum 1% INCLAR COUNTESERVE.
