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Executive Summary

Government Code section 70352(c) requires that the Judicial Council submit a report to the Legislature on actual expenditures from the Court Facilities Trust Fund after the end of each fiscal year. In 2018–19, the fund expended \$106,590,140.

Relevant Previous Council Action

As required, these reports are submitted to the Legislature annually. Reports from previous fiscal years are available at www.courts.ca.gov/7466.htm.

Analysis/Rationale

The annual submission of this report to the Legislature is required under Government Code section 70352(c). The statute requires that the Judicial Council submit the actual expenditures from the Court Facilities Trust Fund. According to Government Code section 70352(b), "Money deposited in [the Court Facilities Trust Fund] and appropriated by the Legislature shall be administered by the Judicial Council for the operation, repair, and maintenance of court facilities and other purposes provided by statute." In 2018–19, the fund expended \$106,590,140 for these purposes, broken down by category in the table below:
