

What is a dashboard?

- At-a-glance view of key performance metrics
- Not a report
- Represents a specific moment in time
- Indicator of potential trends






Use Case #1: Trial Court Operational Dashboards

Use data for instrumentation to manage daily operations and for planning

Bring analytics to courts with limited technical resources

Trial Court Operational Dashboard: Year Over Year Counts



- Counts compared to previous year-to-date
- More contemporary information than currently available

Use Case #2: Appellate Operational Dashboards






Ability to create standardized and ad hoc reports that can be shared across all Appellate Courts.

Improved ability to track and manage case activity and prepare statistical reports.

Appellate Operations Dashboards: Opinions Filed



Shows seasonal variation and allows for planning

 Display multiple years of reports in a single panel

Use Case #3: Jury and Case Data

Use data to serve the public more effectively by:

- accurately determining the number of jurors needed given case characteristics and past performance
- reducing number of jurors summonsed but not called


Use Case #4 JBSIS Data Submission Matrix

- Modernizes data submission process
- Allows for better data validation



Monthly UD filings


July 2018 through June 2022 (58 courts reporting)



Pilot steps completed

- Design a technical platform
- Establish connection between courts and new platform
- Court mapping case management data to a common data dictionary
- Test and validate data submission process


Technical Architecture



Pilot evaluation candidate criteria

- Do the pilot projects offer value to courts?
- Does the technical solution meet the pilot requirements?
- Will the platform provide better access to public data?
- Can the pilot outcomes be replicated across all courts?

Data Analytics/Data Integration Roadmap



Future work requires additional funding for branchwide deployment

- Onboarding additional courts to pilot platform
- Data warehouse to include JBSIS 4.0 Standards
- Additional data sources and reporting requirements
- Increase data validation cycles
- Move beyond foundational data reporting
