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### Executive Summary

Under Government Code section 69958, the Judicial Council is required to report to the Legislature semiannually on the purchase and lease of any electronic recording equipment that will be used to record superior court proceedings. For the reporting period of January 1 through June 30, 2025, 10 superior courts reported a combined total of \$729,435 for the purchase or lease of electronic recording equipment or related items. On or before December 31, 2025, the Judicial Council staff submitted the *Report of Electronic Recording Equipment Purchased or Leased by Superior Courts (January 1 through June 30, 2025)* to the Legislature.

### Relevant Previous Reporting or Action

This report is submitted to the Legislature semiannually. Reports from previous fiscal years are available on the “Reports to the Legislature” webpage of the California Courts website at [courts.ca.gov/news-reference/reports-publications/reports-legislature](http://courts.ca.gov/news-reference/reports-publications/reports-legislature).

### Analysis/Rationale

Government Code section 69957(a) allows the purchase or lease of electronic recording equipment for limited civil, misdemeanor, and infraction cases. Additionally, Government Code section 69957(b) allows the trial courts to use electronic recording equipment for the purpose of monitoring the performance of subordinate judicial officers, hearing officers, and temporary judges. Lastly, Government Code section 69957(c) requires the courts to obtain advance

approval from the Judicial Council before purchasing or leasing any such equipment. Approval is subject to the equipment being used in the manner and for the purposes authorized under this section.

For this reporting period, 10 superior courts reported a combined total of \$729,435 for the purchase or lease of electronic recording equipment or related items (see Attachment A):

- Butte: \$81,832 for use in misdemeanor case types;
- Contra Costa: \$271,510 for use in infraction and misdemeanor case types;
- El Dorado<sup>1</sup>: \$10,340 for use in various case types;
- Los Angeles: \$66,754 for use in limited civil case types;
- Madera: \$100,581 for use in limited civil case types;
- Orange: \$26,536 for use in limited civil case types;
- Riverside: \$30,004 for use in limited civil case types;
- Sacramento: \$45,526 for use in limited civil and misdemeanor case types;
- San Bernardino: \$89,250 for use in infraction, limited civil, and misdemeanor case types; and
- San Mateo: \$7,102 for use in infraction, limited civil, and misdemeanor case types.

The semiannual submission of this report to the Legislature is required under Government Code section 69958. The statute requires that each superior court report to the Judicial Council the purchase and lease of all electronic recording equipment that will be used to record court proceedings, specifying all of the following:

- The superior court in which the equipment will be used;
- The types of trial court proceedings in which the equipment will be used;
- The cost of purchasing, leasing, or upgrading the equipment; and
- The type of equipment purchased or leased.<sup>1</sup>

## **Fiscal Impact and Policy Implications**

The requirements of this report do not result in any additional costs or operational impacts.
