Executive Summary

As outlined in the California Rules of Court, rule 10.16, the Technology Committee oversees the Judicial Council's policies concerning information technology. The committee assists the council by providing technology recommendations focusing on the establishment of policies that emphasize long-term strategic leadership and align with judicial branch goals. The committee is responsible for ensuring that specific projects approved and funded by the council comply with the relevant council policies, proceed on schedule, and stay within scope and budget. This report summarizes the committee's activities since the last Judicial Council internal committee written report, which was submitted for the council's July 21, 2023, business meeting.

Overview of Committee Meetings

Information Technology Advisory Committee

Since the most recent Judicial Council meeting, the Information Technology Advisory Committee (ITAC), overseen by the Technology Committee, held an open meeting on August 9, 2023. ITAC approved the recommended allocations to the Language Access Signage and Technology Grant Program for fiscal year (FY) 2023–24, which was then recommended to the Technology Committee. ITAC also received an update on the hybrid workstream activities and reports on activities and news coming from ITAC liaisons to partnering advisory bodies.

Technology Committee

Since the July 21, 2023, Judicial Council meeting, the Technology Committee held one open meeting on August 14, 2023. The committee also approved the recommended allocations to the Language Access Signage and Technology Grant Program for FY 2023–24 for recommendation to the Judicial Council to consider at its September 19 meeting. The Technology Committee also reviewed the updated California Courts Connected framework and made recommendations to refine further.

IT Modernization Funding Program

The committee reviewed and approved the branchwide programs and the information security program budgets for FY 2023–24.
