Executive Summary

As outlined in California Rules of Court, rule 10.11, the Executive and Planning Committee oversees the Judicial Council's meeting process and operating procedures, including agenda setting for council meetings, development of the council's long-range strategic plan for the judicial branch, and development of policies and procedures related to court facilities and communications with the branch. The committee is also charged with directing the nominations process for vacancies on the council and its advisory bodies and education curriculum committees, and overseeing specific advisory bodies. This report summarizes the committee's activities since the last Judicial Council internal committee written report, which was submitted for the council's January 19, 2024, business meeting.

Overview of Committee Meetings

The Executive and Planning Committee will have met twice by videoconference between the January 19 and March 15, 2024, Judicial Council meetings.

Agenda setting and other business

During its February 14, 2024, videoconference, the committee set the agenda for the council's March 15 business meeting. The committee also conducted additional business during the February 14 videoconference as summarized below.

Study pretrial delays in Sexually Violent Predator Act cases

During the February 14 meeting, the committee approved three recommendations from Judicial Council staff: (1) Consider the recommendation of the Supreme Court in *Camacho v. Superior Court* (2023) 15 Cal.5th 354 to study the issue of pretrial delays in sexually violent predator cases; (2) Direct the Administrative Director of the Judicial Council to refer the review of pretrial delays in sexually violent predator cases to the Criminal Justice Services office for study; and (3) Require the Administrative Director or their delegate to report back to the Executive and Planning Committee with recommended action items within six months.
