## **Executive Summary**

In accordance with Government Code section 68555.5, the Judicial Council submitted the required report to the Legislature, 2024 Training for Judicial Officers Pursuant to Gov. Code, § 68555.5. The attached report conveys the titles of the training courses offered by the Judicial Council pursuant to Government Code section 68555 and the number of judicial officers who participated in each training.

### **Relevant Previous Reporting or Action**

To meet the requirements of Government Code section 68555, effective January 1, 2025, the Judicial Council established judicial training programs for individuals who perform duties in domestic violence or child custody matters, including judges, commissioners, and referees. The training programs are ongoing training and education programs designed to improve the ability of courts to (1) recognize and respond to child physical abuse, child sexual abuse, domestic violence, and trauma in family victims, particularly children; and (2) make appropriate custody decisions that prioritize child safety and well-being, and are culturally sensitive and appropriate for diverse communities. The report has been sent directly to the Legislature from Judicial Council staff, as required by Government Code section 68555.5.

## Analysis/Rationale

Government Code section 68555.5 states the following:

The Judicial Council shall report to the Legislature and the relevant policy committees, on or before January 1, 2025, and each January thereafter, on the trainings for judicial officers provided pursuant to Section 68555. The report shall include both of the following:

- (a) The titles of the training courses being offered by Judicial Council.
- (b) The number of judicial officers that participated in each training.

This report fulfills the requirements of the statute. (See Attachment A.)
