### Executive Summary

As outlined in rule 10.16 of the California Rules of Court, the Technology Committee oversees the Judicial Council's policies concerning information technology. The committee assists the council by providing technology recommendations focusing on the establishment of policies that emphasize long-term strategic leadership and align with judicial branch goals. The committee is responsible for ensuring that specific projects approved and funded by the council comply with relevant council policies, proceed on schedule, and stay within scope and budget. This report summarizes the committee's activities since the last Judicial Council internal committee written report, which was submitted for the council's business meeting on July 18, 2025.

### Overview of Committee Meetings

#### Information Technology Advisory Committee

The Information Technology Advisory Committee (ITAC), overseen by the Technology Committee, held an open meeting on September 25, 2025, at which it received an update on (1) rule 10.430 of the California Rules of Court, Generative artificial intelligence use policies; (2) standard 10.80 of the California Standards of Judicial Administration, Use of generative artificial intelligence by judicial officers; and (3) local court-generative artificial intelligence use policies and related considerations. ITAC also began the discussion of its 2026 annual agenda.

ITAC held an open meeting on October 21, 2025, at which it continued discussions and planning of its 2026 annual agenda.

**Technology Committee**

The Technology Committee held an open meeting on September 8, 2025, at which it approved the fiscal year 2025–26 budgets for the IT Modernization Funding for the branchwide and appellate information technology programs.
