## **Executive Summary**

Pursuant to Government Code section 68502.5(c)(2)(C), the Judicial Council is required to submit a report to the Legislature and the Department of Finance by October 1 of each year that accounts for all trial court requests and allocations from the authorized reserve in the Trial Court Trust Fund for unforeseen emergencies. On or before October 1, 2023, Judicial Council staff submitted the *Report of Allocation of the State-Level Reserve in the Trial Court Trust Fund in 2022–23*.

## **Relevant Previous Council Action**

## Analysis/Rationale

Government Code section 68502.5(c)(2)(B) requires the Judicial Council to establish a process for trial courts to apply for emergency funding if needed and authorizes a reserve of \$10 million in the Trial Court Trust Fund from which the trial courts can apply for that funding (Link A).

The Judicial Council is required to annually report to the Legislature and the Department of Finance all requests and allocations made pursuant to this section. This year's report to the Legislature communicates that no requests for emergency funding were submitted by the trial courts to the Judicial Council in 2022–23.

## **Fiscal Impact and Policy Implications**

There was no fiscal impact in 2022–23 because the trial courts did not request emergency funding. Had a request been submitted and approved in 2022–23, each court's 2023–24 base allocation would have been proportionally reduced to replenish the reserve.
