<u>19-085</u> Pretrial Reform | Pretrial Pilot Program Recommended Awards

(Action Required)

Summary: As part of the Budget Act of 2019, the Legislature allocated \$75 million to the

Judicial Council to fund the implementation, operation, and evaluation of programs or efforts related to pretrial decisionmaking in at least 10 courts. The Pretrial Reform and

Operations Workgroup (PROW) undertook an extensive process to solicit and

review applications for funding from the superior courts.

From that process, PROW selected 16 courts and recommends approving Pretrial Pilot Program funding allocations and distribution to those courts, as well as authorization of further pilot program funding opportunities for the courts and authorization of Judicial Council staff to undertake pilot program grant administration

activities.
