Executive Summary

As outlined in the California Rules of Court, rule 10.16, the Technology Committee oversees the Judicial Council's policies concerning information technology. The committee assists the council by providing technology recommendations focusing on the establishment of policies that emphasize long-term strategic leadership and that align with judicial branch goals. The committee is responsible for ensuring specific projects approved and funded by the council comply with the relevant council policies, proceed on schedule, and stay within scope and budget.

Overview of Committee Meetings

Since the September 20, 2022, Judicial Council meeting, the Technology Committee met by videoconference for an open meeting on October 3, 2022. The committee also conducted one action by email and held a new member orientation.

Information Technology Advisory Committee (ITAC)

The Information Technology Advisory Committee (ITAC) held two open meetings. The September 28, 2022, agenda included Language Access Signage and Technology grant recommendations; the new Strategic Plan for Technology; as well as orientations on developing legislation and the IT Modernization Fund program. ITAC also received presentations on

branchwide programs extending from the committee's workstreams, including Virtual Customer Service Center and Data Analytics. The October 26 meeting was held to discuss the committee's Annual Agenda and receive an update on JBSIS 4.0.

IT Modernization Fund and other Grant Funding

Following the Judicial Council's approval of the fiscal year (FY) 2022–23 Court Technology Modernization Funding program (heretofore IT Modernization Fund program) allocations, Intra-Branch Agreements were distributed to the courts. The branchwide workstream is developing metrics for use in the court progress reports. The first progress report is due January 17, 2023.

Additionally, the Technology Committee approved the Jury Management System grant funding for FY 2022-23.

Tactical Plan for Technology Update 2023-24

The Information Technology Advisory Committee is sponsoring a workstream to update the Tactical Plan for Technology for 2023–24. It is anticipated that the public comment period will take place in early 2023.
