Executive Summary

Pursuant to Government Code section 69958, the Judicial Council is required to report to the Legislature semiannually on the purchase and lease of any electronic recording equipment that will be used to record superior court proceedings. During the reporting period of January 1 to June 30, 2022, four courts reported a combined total of \$279,951 for equipment or related items. On or before December 31, 2022, the Judicial Council's Budget Services staff submitted the Report of Electronic Recording Equipment Purchased or Leased by Superior Courts (January 1 through June 30, 2022).

Relevant Previous Council Action

This report is submitted to the Legislature semiannually. Reports from previous fiscal years are available on the California Courts website "Legislative Reports" webpage at www.courts.ca.gov/7466.htm.

Analysis/Rationale

Government Code section 69957(a) allows the purchase and/or lease of electronic recording equipment for limited civil, misdemeanor, infraction, and small claims cases. Additionally, Government Code section 69957(c) requires the courts to obtain advance approval from the Judicial Council before purchasing or leasing any such equipment. Approval is subject to the equipment being used in the manner and for the purposes authorized under this section.

From January 1 through June 31, 2022, four courts reported a combined total of \$279,951 for the purchase or lease of equipment or related items:

- Butte Superior Court obligated \$245,496 for the full lease term of electronic recording equipment for use in misdemeanor case types and possibly other case types as authorized by law (see Attachment A).
- Colusa Superior Court spent \$8,880 to purchase electronic recording equipment for use in limited civil, misdemeanor, infraction, and small claims case types (see Attachment B).
- Merced Superior Court spent \$10,929 to purchase electronic recording equipment for use in limited civil, misdemeanor, infraction, and small claims case types (see Attachment C).
- San Mateo Superior Court spent \$14,646 to purchase electronic recording equipment for use in misdemeanor, unlawful detainer, and jury trial case types (see Attachment D).

The semiannual submission of this report to the Legislature is required pursuant to Government Code section 69958. The statute requires that each superior court report to the Judicial Council the purchase and lease of all electronic recording equipment that will be used to record court proceedings, specifying all of the following:

- The superior court in which the equipment will be used;
- The types of trial court proceedings in which the equipment will be used;
- The cost of purchasing, leasing, or upgrading the equipment; and
- The type of equipment purchased or leased.

Pursuant to Government Code 69958, the Judicial Council is submitting the semiannual *Report of Electronic Recording Equipment Purchased or Leased by Superior Courts*, for the reporting period of January 1 through June 30, 2022.

Government Code 69957(a) allows the purchase or lease of electronic recording equipment for limited civil, misdemeanor, infraction, and small claims cases. The report specifies the name of the court, types of proceedings for which the equipment will be used, cost of the equipment, and types of equipment purchased or leased.

During the January 1 through June 30, 2022 reporting period, four courts reported a combined total of \$279,951 for the purchase or lease of equipment or related items:

- Butte Superior Court obligated \$245,496 for the full lease term of electronic recording equipment for use in misdemeanor case types and may extend the use to other case types as authorized (see Attachment A).
- Colusa Superior Court spent \$8,880 to purchase electronic recording equipment for use in limited civil, misdemeanor, infraction, and small claims case types (see Attachment B).
- Merced Superior Court spent \$10,929 to purchase electronic recording equipment for use in limited civil, misdemeanor, infraction, and small claims case types (see Attachment C).
- San Mateo Superior Court spent \$14,646 to purchase electronic recording equipment for use in misdemeanor, unlawful detainer, and jury trial case types (see Attachment D).
