

- Problems:
- 72% of all FL Litigants are self-represented
- Even simple divorces are often incomprehensible to pro-pers
- And yet the biggest complaint from our customers is that the process takes too long





- In our courtrooms daily –"Are we divorced yet?"
- Explaining process to nervous, litigant without legal trainingdeer in headlights
- BUT no money, no resources
- And yet the need to do more with less
- One small contribution to the solution.....



- Start with:
 - 1) Defaults
 - 2) Uncontested couples
- First triage: Website, brochures and signs in courthouse:
 - 1) Service and POS and 30 days or
 - 2) Response filed but parties agree on EVERYTHING, C/C, C/S, S/S, Prop. Etc
- "Skim the cream off the bottom" rather than, "low-hanging fruit"

- Second triage: Self-help Center pulls file and does a once-over
- VOLUNTEERS: No cost!!(Therefore means test...)
- Third triage: Temporary Judges (Judge Pro-Tems) – review, recommend, instruct re: needed forms
- Forth triage: Law Students (willing!!!) and 0-10's, type info on computer legal forms (AND ISSUE SPOT) and return to Temporary Judges for final approval





- Then the fun begins!!!!!!!!!!
- Final check and approval in Department 123
- Extoll the virtues of the process and especially the volunteers; introduce the volunteers and welcome their expression of gratitude to the volunteers (reminder to customer of service and encouragement to volunteers)

- Minimal Court Resources:
- Facilitator pulls files and early triage
- Judge hears cases at 11:30; 1:30 and 2:30 i.e. before and after lunch and at a recess during normal trial day
- DCSS on duty for C/S??
- FCS on duty for C/C??



- Early numbers: 10 per Friday on
 2 Fridays each month =
 20/month (10 computers only)
- Expansion?? 4 Fridays (40 cases) or 4 Thursdays and Fridays (80 cases/month); Coordinate with regular volunteer settlement conference calendar daily?
- Future with money \$\$\$\$?
- FT Atty/Pro-Tem plus 3-4 paralegals could crank out 100's each month

Five Minute FOAH



- The Problem:
- Minute orders issued at hearing
- Weeks/Months before a Formal Order After Hearing (FOAH) is prepared
- Peace Officers may not enforce (or be able to read) a minute order
- Is there a way to go from decision directly to a FOAH?
- Solution??





- What if a judge could type directly on a FOAH?
- What if a judge could dictate directly to a FOAH?
- Eliminate the minute order step entirely?
- Voila! Five Minute FOAH



- Judge (or Clerk) types (or dictates) orders and <u>program</u> <u>populates all applicable</u> <u>Judicial Council forms.</u>
- Again judge or clerk can produce the FOAH – Culture of the individual courts
- Multiple check boxes and templates to shorten process




- Program knows what forms have to accompany what orders and attaches them automatically
- PLUS: Program can import FCS recommendations (and Court can make changes on that recommendation
- □ PLUS: Program can import results screen from X-Spouse support calculation



- Available on line immediately to parties who have registered
- Revolutionary benefit to selfrepresented litigants who may never know how bad it was
- Future??
- Scan written stips to attach to the FOAH, etc
