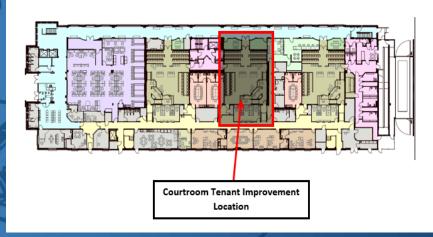

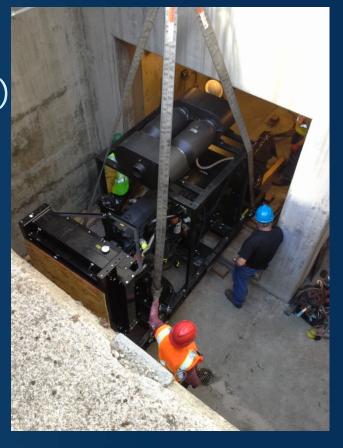

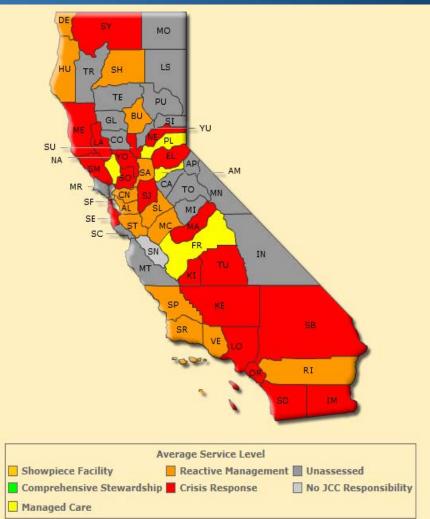

Trial Court Facilities -Statewide View

Service levels:

 Showpiece Quality Facilities are maintained at the highest level; majority of maintenance work is preventive. Equipment and building are fully functional and in excellent operating condition. (Judicial Council goal). Equipment and building are usually functional and in good condition. Some reactive maintenance and emergency response is needed. Response is timely to service requests. Managed Care Equipment and building components are mostly functional, with occasional breakdowns. Maintenance performed is more reactive than preventive. Response to service requests takes a little longer. Reactive Management Equipment and building components are frequently broken and inoperative, and they continue to deteriorate. Maintenance is almost exclusively reactive, and response is no longer timely. Building components and equipment are routinely broken and inoperative. Wear and tear continues unabated. Preventive maintenance is no longer performed, and response is limited to emergencies.

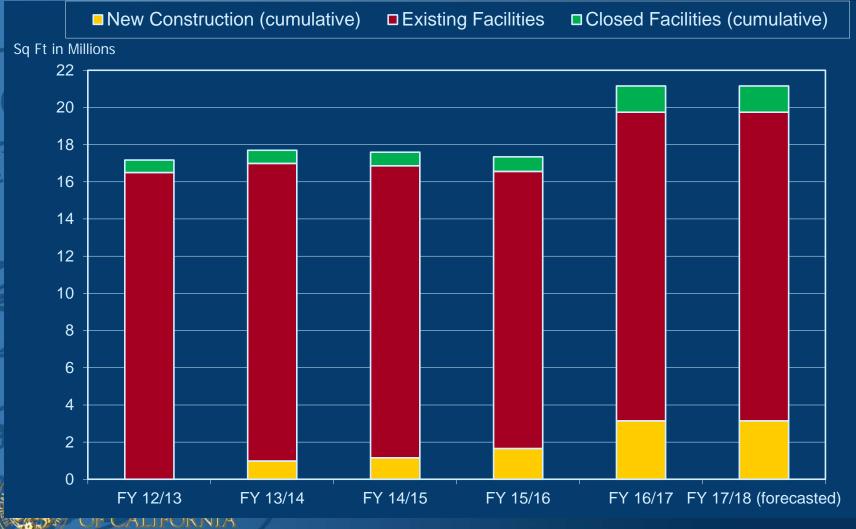
