Background

AB 590 (Feuer) was initially 6 year pilot project
Findings from initial report and Judicial Council support led to elimination of sunset



Next steps

 Independent evaluation has demonstrated value of the project

 Next round of 3 year grants to support projects and evaluate potential best practices



Structure for Pilot

 Lead legal services agency which works with others who help with conflicts, multiple representation

 Partnership with the court which is to provide services to assist those litigants who remain unrepresented



Funding

 From designated postjudgment filing fees Anticipated to be \$11 million • 2011 - \$9.5 million 2017 - \$7.2 million



Recommendation process

 Legislatively mandated committee RFP issued All proposals considered by the committee in light of the evaluation IDICIAL COUNCIL



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Unanimous Recommendations committee

1) Fund Existing Programs Kern - housing Los Angeles – custody / housing San Diego – custody / housing Northern Santa Barbara county – probate/housing San Francisco - custody Yolo - housing JDICIAL COUNCIL

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And one new program

Fresno - housing



2) Level of funding

 Amount project received last year or amount of request (whichever is less) was baseline

 Proportionate decrease in all programs



Formula

 Custody project limited by statute to 20% of funding Reduction divided proportionately among custody projects = 26%reduction Left housing & probate with 19% reduction



Implementation

 Programs have been asked to provide a revised budget and project plan based upon recommended amounts

 Committee requests authority to review and approve those budgets and plans



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Cy Pres funds

Budget Trailer bill provides that a portion of cy pres funds may be allocated for Shriver pilot projects Will work with Judicial Council staff on implementation



Equal Access funds

Equal Access Fund increased by \$10 million. Thus, additional \$1 million available for Partnership Grants, self help services run by legal aid at the Court Many Shriver projects have a component that is appropriate for that funding and have been invited to apply



Next steps

Focused studies on promising practices such as:
Focused settlement services
Social worker on legal team
Continuum of services



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Recommendation

 Approve Sargent Shriver Civil Counsel Act Implementation Committee's recommendations re: grants

 Authorize committee to review and approve revised budgets and project plans



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
