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Title

Court Realignment Data for Calendar Year 2016

Submitted by

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Executive Summary

Penal Code section 13155 requires the Judicial Council, commencing January 1, 2013, to collect information from trial courts regarding the implementation of the 2011 Criminal Justice Realignment Legislation and make the data available annually to the California Department of Finance (DOF), Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC), and Joint Legislative Budget Committee (JLBC) by September 1. This is the fourth annual court realignment data report to the DOF, BSCC, and JLBC. The report, *Court Realignment Data (Calendar Year 2016)*, is included as Attachment A to this report.

Previous Council Action

The first annual report of data collected from the trial courts on the implementation of the 2011 Realignment Legislation was provided to the Judicial Council by its staff at the council's August 23, 2013, meeting. The annual reports for subsequent years were provided at the August 22, 2014, August 21, 2015, and August 26, 2016 meetings. Each report was then sent to the DOF, BSCC, and JLBC by September 1.

Methodology and Process

Penal Code section 13155 (Sen. Bill 1021; Stats. 2012, ch. 41) states that trial courts shall

provide to the Judicial Council not less frequently than twice a year data that includes “statistics for each county regarding the dispositions of felonies at sentencing and petitions to revoke probation, postrelease community supervision, mandatory supervision, and, commencing July 1, 2013, parole.”

Criminal Justice Realignment Data Working Group

The Judicial Council’s Court Executives Advisory Committee formed an ad hoc working group to identify and define appropriate realignment-related data elements. This working group, the Criminal Justice Realignment Data Working Group, was composed of representatives from the superior courts of Alameda, Fresno, Los Angeles, Napa, Orange, Shasta, and Ventura Counties. The working group implemented quarterly reporting requirements and identified 29 data points to track sentencing and disposition information and court workload. After receiving feedback from the trial courts, various data points were edited and new data elements created to better track outcomes and court workload. These changes were implemented in quarter four of 2013, and no changes have been made since then. A list of current data elements is included in Attachment B.

Data collection and quality assurance

Trial courts submit data quarterly to the Judicial Council’s Criminal Justice Services office using an online survey. The data reporting schedule for 2016 was as follows:

- Quarter 1 (January 1, 2016–March 31, 2016) data due April 30, 2016
- Quarter 2 (April 1, 2016–June 30, 2016) data due July 31, 2016
- Quarter 3 (July 1, 2016–September 30, 2016) data due October 31, 2016
- Quarter 4 (October 1, 2016–December 31, 2016) data due January 31, 2017

The Judicial Council staff conducts quality assurance to examine the accuracy and reliability of the data collected. Judicial Council staff reviews reported data on a biannual basis, and contacts trial courts to discuss data quality, provide technical assistance regarding data collection, and to gather information about local court processes. When necessary, courts revise their data as a result of these checks. The data presented in the *Court Realignment Data (Calendar Year 2016)* report may be amended in subsequent reports as courts may revise previous data entries. Although a number of courts have significant reporting challenges and are unable to provide complete data, data quality have continued to improve as a result of this cooperative effort and as the courts continue to refine their data reporting systems.^{1,2}

¹ Many courts are implementing new case/data management systems. This, along with staffing and workload limitations, has presented significant and ongoing barriers to reporting many of the data elements in the report. Courts facing the greatest limitations have been instructed to prioritize items directly linked to Criminal Justice Realignment allocation methodology (i.e. Petitions to revoke/modify PRCS and Petitions to revoke/modify Parole).

² The totals presented in this statistical report may vary from those in JBSIS or the annual Court Statistics Report due to differences in reporting protocols and data definitions.

Policy and Cost Implications

In addition to fulfilling a legislative mandate, data collected under Penal Code section 13155 are used to assist the Trial Court Budget Advisory Committee in determining realignment funding allocations. Approximately \$36.9 million has been allocated since fiscal year 2013–2014. The current allocation formula is based on each courts' proportion of the new workload associated with realignment, as measured by the total petitions filed to revoke and/or modify postrelease community supervision and parole. All courts are able to report the data elements currently used to establish funding allocations.

Court Realignment Data (Calendar Year 2016)

This report fulfills the requirement pursuant to Penal Code section 13155 that the Judicial Council submit data regarding the implementation of the 2011 Criminal Justice Realignment Legislation to the California Department of Finance (DOF), the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC), and the Joint Legislative Budget Committee (JLBC).

Please note the following:

- 1) The data presented in Tables 1-5 reflect the annual total of each item for all quarters reported by each court to the Judicial Council. The reporting period is calendar year 2016 (January 1, 2016–December 31, 2016). These data reports may be revised and amended to correct initial data reporting errors or to complete partially entered reports, but are current as of May 30, 2017. The reporting schedule for 2016 was as follows:
 - **Quarter 1:** January 1, 2016–March 31, 2016 (data due April 30, 2016)
 - **Quarter 2:** April 1, 2016–June 30, 2016 (data due July 31, 2016)
 - **Quarter 3:** July 1, 2016–September 30, 2016 (data due October 31, 2016)
 - **Quarter 4:** October 1, 2016–December 31, 2016 (data due January 31, 2017)
- 2) Many courts began implementing new case/data management systems, and are still in the process of this transition. This has presented significant and ongoing barriers to reporting many of the data elements in the report. In spite of these challenges, approximately 84% of the courts were able to report most (70% or more) of the requested data. The following notations are used for courts reporting partial data:
 - * Reported one quarter of data.
 - ** Reported two quarters of data.
 - *** Reported three quarters of data.
- 3) Note that the “n” for each data element is the total number of courts reporting any data for that item, including courts reporting less than 4 quarters. Please see Attachment B for a full description of each data point.
