





OUR CHARGE:



VIDEO CONFERENCING

Expand access to the video-conferenced multi-site workshop platform created through SHARP. Using this platform, one legal assistant can support up to 50 people remotely through a single, live workshop that traditionally served significantly fewer participants.



BROADBAND ACCESS

Improve the current broadband capacity of each site within the 22 counties to support real-time video conferencing. Gaps in internet coverage are still noted throughout the state, often contributing to the digital divide.



TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE

Establish processes and systems to build the remote-access technology infrastructure.



REMOTE LEGAL SERVICES

Design and build the platform that will set the foundation for litigants to video conference from their home via mobile devices and computers.

Design and implement legal workshops that will be available via video conference to the 22 counties.




