






# Los Angeles Superior Court


- **Michael D. Antonovich Antelope Valley Courthouse**




- **3 issues**

# Los Angeles Superior Court

- Aging buildings
- Stanley Mosk (1958), Foltz (1972) and Compton (1977)
  - frequent elevator malfunctions
  - seismic concerns

# Los Angeles Superior Court

- **Deferred maintenance**
- **Floods**
- **Elevators non-operational**



# Los Angeles Superior Court

- Innovations
- Self-help
  - 7,000 workshops
  - 250,000 events
- STAR
  - 75%-80% grad. H.S.
  - Recidivism declined
