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Executive Summary

Government Code section 70371.8 requires the Judicial Council to report annually to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee and the chairs of the Senate Committee on Budget and Fiscal Review and the Assembly Committee on Budget on the status of the judicial branch courthouse construction program.

The report includes information on the status of each project established by the State Public Works Board under section Government Code 70371.7, and a detailed accounting of the \$220.1 million in revenues and \$263 million in expenditures, including \$32.2 million for capital outlay expenses from the Immediate and Critical Needs Account (ICNA) in 2018–19.

Relevant Previous Council Action

The report on the status of courthouse capital projects in the judicial branch courthouse construction program (Attachment A) and accounting of the revenues and expenditures in the ICNA has been required and submitted under Government Code section 70371.8 since 2008–09. The council has approved previous reports, and they are posted on the California Courts website at www.courts.ca.gov/7466.htm.

Analysis/Rationale

Revenues are collected from fines and fees to support the ICNA. The revenues are submitted to the State Controller's Office by either courts or counties, depending on the entity that is responsible for collection.

ICNA makes expenditures in five major areas: facility modifications, Los Angeles–Long Beach Service Fee, lease revenue debt service, support of the trial courts, and capital projects. Reconciliation of this report for both revenue and expenditures match year-end financial statements, and are captured and detailed on Attachment B.

Fiscal Impact and Policy Implications

Minimal implementation costs are associated with this report, and there are no operational impacts.
