### **Trial Courts | Public Notice by Courts of Closures or Reduced Clerks' Office Hours**

#### Summary

Government Code section 68106 directs (1) trial courts to notify the public and the Judicial Council before closing courtrooms or clerks' offices, or reducing clerks' regular office hours; and (2) the council to post all such notices on its website and relay them to the Legislature. This report lists the latest court notices received by the council under this statutory requirement. Since the previous report, two superior courts-the Superior Courts of San Benito County and Ventura County-have issued new notices.
